Amend Road Paving discussion- Councilman Johnston stated he was asked by a resident for the town to hold off paving Amend Road. Discussion was held. Town board would like to continue with paving Amend Road this year.

Transfer site- problem with contractors that are not working in Orleans using landfill. Discussion was held. Contractors must show proof of working for Town of Orleans residents.

5. Rob Campany update- Rob gave the town board update on library project, waiting on front door. Project should be complete in a couple of weeks.

6. Accountant- Councilman Wilson asked where we are at with reports and accounting status. Discussion was held. Supervisor Rarick will contact Stackel and Navarra tomorrow.
